TGF's Youth Advisory Group is a group of dedicated high school students who live in Guilford and function as a grantmaking/ fundraising community service board.

Since our inception in 2010, we've awarded over \$166,000 to youth-centered organizations through 112 community grants. Additionally, we've distributed 41 grants totaling \$80,962 to GHS clubs and programs through the Guilford Institute Fund since 2016.

Our fundraisers events such as Project Luminaria at the Guilford Tree Lighting, appeal letters, and more.

Membership is limited to 20 students.
